The D-end moulded top with lovely fluted detailing to the edges is raised over a simple frieze and supported on elegantly tapering, ring turned legs with exquisite scrolling foliate and fluted motif detail, terminating on gorgeous, finely cast brass and ceramic casters with decorative beaded row detailing.
