The front is richly pierced with symmetrical scrolling and small flower details, giving a light, lace-like appearance. The buckle is constructed as two matching panels that meet centrally to create a complete mirrored pattern. The reverse shows a practical belt fitting with bar attachments and a central clasp mechanism for secure wear. Hallmarked for Birmingham, 1907. Measurements: Height: 2 1/4" (approx. 5.5cm) Width: 3" (approx. 7.5cm) Silver weight: 24g In good condition – The silver shows only light surface wear consistent with age and gentle handling.
