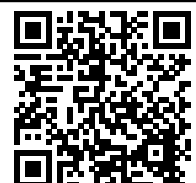

The bindings remain tight. Bookplate for 'Library Bocket Hall' (Hertfordshire) and 'Lord W. Kerr G.C.B.' to the front pastedown. Lord Walter Kerr (1839-1925) G.C.B was Admiral of the Fleet; the highest rank in the Royal Navy. In retirement he lived at Melnbourne Hall, Derbyshire, which his wife had inherited, along with Bocket Hall and the manor of Ayot St. Peter. Small ink name inscription to the top of the title page of Volume I and some light spotting throughout, predominantly to the preliminary pages. A scarce set.
