Closterman was a leader in the race to be London's leading society portraitist and the sitters would have been acquainted with his talent. Closterman (also spelled Cloosterman, Klosterman) was born in Osnabrück (now lower Saxony), the son of an artist who taught him the rudiments of design. In 1679 he went to Paris, where he worked for two years in the studio of François de Troy - his work reflec...
