A young woman is depicted standing by a path outside a thatched cottage. As she feeds birds on the ground, others are shown alighting from nearby blossom trees. To the right of the figure, a stream can be seen winding around a haybarn, whilst in the distance beyond the peaks of a hill range provide a dramatic backdrop. The topography is similar to that of the Brendon Hills near Exmoor, which the artist is known to have painted. Robert John Hammond was a landscape painter born in Blackfriars, London in 1853. By the time he was 18 he had moved to Sutton Coldfield where he initially became an apprentice watchmaker before becoming a full time artist. In 1871, he married Lucy Banner, the sister of the artist Alfred Banner (1860-1914) at Kings Norton, Worcestershire. They lived at 90 Kyrwicks Lane, Bordesley in Birmingham before moving to 467 Moseley Road, Balsall Heat...
