Vincent Clare (1855 - 1925) was a Birmingham painter of fruit and flower subjects. He was the son of George Clare and brother of Oliver Clare, also both highly regarded Victorian still life painters.. Vincent Clare lived in Southgate, London, although was known to have exhibited at the Walker Art Gallery in Liverpool between 1888 and 1897.
