DESCRIPTION A handsome George III mahogany hanging corner cupboard, of Whitehaven type, dating from around 1800. Of particularly attractive architectural form, the cupboard is surmounted by a shaped swan-neck pediment with brass roundels, above a moulded cornice and frieze. The large panelled door incorporates a beautifully figured mahogany central panel and is flanked by characteristic fluted canted corners. The door opens to reveal a fitted interior with shaped shelves, providing useful storage while retaining the elegant proportions expected of a Georgian hanging corner cupboard. The quality and choice of timber are particularly appealing, with good colour and attractive figuring to the mahogany. The cupboard retains its original lock together with a working key. A substantial and decorative piece of late Georgian country-house furniture, equally suitable for practical storage or display.
