Size: 7ft 7in x 5ft 9in (230 x 176cm) excluding tassels. Antique Yomut Turkmen tribal embroidered felt ceremonial horse blanket. Circa 1900. This horse blanket belongs to a small group of well known ceremonial horse blankets woven by the Yomut Turkmen tribes of Turkmenistan. The blanket is finely embroidered in wool on a thick dense un-dyed brown wool felt. These blankets of thick heavy felt were mainly for use during the colder winter months. The blanket is in exceptionally good original condition, with very slight wear and signs of use. A superb collectible display item.
