Description

This George III satinwood and sabicu cabinet attributed to George Simson dates to circa 1780-1790 and is of breakfront form, incorporating a secretaire drawer beneath a mirrored upper door above a pair of panelled cupboard doors. The cabinet is veneered in finely figured West Indian satinwood and sabicu, with the upper section displaying a solid West Indian satinwood thumbnail moulding above a cavetto cornice. Beneath is a recessed cross grain panel flanked by two smaller solid satinwood beadings. The central oval mirror is recessed within the door and framed by mitred corners with tulipwood cross banding, all enclosed within an inlaid and cross banded surround. The mirrored door is flanked by inverted inlaid fluted panels veneered in long grain sabicu, surmounted by tulipwood long grain fluted capitals that terminate above a breakfront satinwood moulded slip. The cabinet is constructed in two sections, with the mirrored door opening to reveal three original adjustable mahogany shelves. The secretaire drawer opens to reveal a well arranged interior fitted with four central pigeon holes and two banks of four graduated satinwood drawers with mahogany linings, retaining t...
