Crafted with structural integrity, the stand features four outswept supports that taper elegantly toward the top. The upper section is fitted with eight shaped double hooks, offering extensive hanging capacity for coats and hats. The lower framework is united by moulded umbrella holders and terminates seamlessly in a robust square base that encloses its original metal drip tray for practical floor protection.
