Art Deco / early 20th century. Inscribed "HELP Scottish K.C. 1925". "Scottish K.C." is considered highly likely to refer to the Scottish Kennel Club. The precise significance of "HELP" remains under historical investigation. Solid bronze with an attractive naturally aged brown patina. Historically evocative Newfoundland maritime-rescue subject. Gorrings, Lewes, 3 March 2025, Lot 427. Original Gorrings auction label survives beneath the sculpture. Approximately 1 kg in weight. Description An intriguing Scottish Art Deco bronze model of a Newfoundland-type dog, dating to 1925 and bearing the unusual period inscription "HELP Scottish K.C. 1925". The animal stands foursquare upon an integral stepped base. Its broad head, substantial paws, powerful body and profuse coat are represented through vigorous surface modelling.
