Retaining its original silvered finish and complete with its original frosted glass shades, ceiling rose and internal ceiling fixing bracket (all very nicely over engineered, nothing like what's being produced today). Professionally rewired with the correct silk braid, and original bulb holders which have been refurbished. PAT safety tested. Complete with new retro LED bulbs, ready to install and enjoy. Height 48cm PROVENANCE: From Barbourne house (Formerly Tintagel) House, Worcester. History: In 1903 Frederick John Mayers, a carpet designer with a studio in George Street, Kidderminster, purchased the land from James Ward, the Younger, and designed Tintagel which was built in 1904. Mayers had previously owned 54 Hill Grove, Kidderminster, which he had commissioned the famous architect, C F A Voysey to design for him in 1899 (noted in the book 'C F A Voysey - Architect and Designer 1857 - 1941' by Brandon-Jones). Mayers was greatly influenced by Voysey when he designed Tintagel and there are many Voysey inspired features, for example the tapered buttresses, the roof lines, the windows including window catches, the...
