An excellent quality mid 19th century French gilt bronze and porcelain mantel clock in the Louis XV style. The case has beautifully cast cherubs to either side, centred by a ram, surmounted with musical instruments and dove with cascading floral garlands. The inset porcelain panels have a blue and gilt border with hand painted birds, musical instruments and a female dressed in traditional attire. The porcelain dial has Roman numerals with a cherub to the centre and the makers name - Henry Marc Paris. The movement is an eight day duration which strikes the hours and half hours on a bell with outside countwheel. The movement backplate is also stamped with the makers name.
