Often mistaken for Faraday & Son examples, this is a distinct and well-made alternative with comparable quality. One leg retains a hanging eye, allowing the lamp to be wall-mounted if desired. The geometry of the form gives it a strong architectural feel, making it equally suited to desks, side tables, or wall placement. Recently rewired and PAT tested.
