Below, the base comprises a secretaire drawer with fall front, opening to a fitted interior with baize writing surface, pigeonholes, and small drawers, above three further graduated drawers. Raised on bracket feet with ebonised banding. A well-considered combination of storage and writing function in a single vertical form. Condition Report In excellent antique condition with a number of historic repairs. One foot and one drawer pull have been replaced. All work is stable and in keeping with the piece.
