The kidney back features a beautifully carved tulip cross splat, while the seat is upholstered in a rich blue fabric, finished with complementary beading. Condition Report In excellent condition, with a historic repair to one of the back legs and a couple of minor scuffs to the front corner moulding - nothing that detracts from its charm.
