This heavy-gauge, custom-forged structural panel exemplifies the peak of Art Deco ferronnerie d'art, showcasing a master artisan's ability to seamlessly blend industrial strength with fluid, stylized organic design. Design & Craftsmanship Unlike mass-produced, flat-profile metalwork of the era, this panel features striking three-dimensional relief sculpture. The focal point is a beautifully executed elliptical 3D , rom the pot bursts a dynamic, multi-layered cluster of 3D agave-style fronds, framed by elegant scrolling tendrils and anchored below by a geometric wave motif. Above, a stylized sunburst in bronze projects clean, radiating iron rays into a sky of fluid, bent-wire clouds—a quintessential and optimistic Art Deco narrative.
