The elegant fluted pillar is surmounted with an exquisite caryatid capital and profusely adorned with beautifully carved motifs comprising of winged putti, winged sphinx, masques, lyres, trumpets, foliate, wreaths, palmette and flowerhead detailing, terminating on paw foot, inscribed 'Sebastian Erard, 18 Great Marlborough Street, London'.
