With sides raised, butler's grasps to each side provide excellent purchase for service from kitchen to stand. Tray sits upon the taut webbed stand, ensuring stable placement during use. Striking X-frame legs with brass handles upon the folding axis. Conveniently folds away for stowage when not in use. This is an attractive antique serving table, the generous tray ideal for moving cocktails and canapés from the kitchen to the lounge or dining room.
