A quality Georgian bracket/table clock by William Gard of Exeter. An arched top, flame mahogany case of neat proportions. A gilded brass edging to the dial and standing on ogee bracket feet. Brass fretwork to the case sides with silk backing. An arched silvered dial with blued steel hands and 5 minute outer dial markers. A strike/silent to the arch and a rarer feature of a circular date dial at the dial lower section. A fine quality, twin fusee, verge escapement mechanism striking the hours on a bell. A well engraved border backplate to the mechanism. A pull repeat cord to the case side. A glass back door showing the mechanism. Circa 1795. The maker, William Gard was born in Exeter, Devon in 1767. He was a talented maker and worked on the Exeter Cathedral clock in 1797. He died in 1805 and was noted in the Exeter newspaper as 'a respectable watchmaker of this city'.
