The image is worked in very fine counted stitches which helps to create a surprisingly painterly effect. Highlights include the footstool which is richly ornamented with gilded scrolling decoration and the delicate pale grey-blue which throws the dog into relief. The warm-toned antique (likely original) burr maple wooden frame complements the red and gold colours of the tapestry within.
