Early Georgian Oak Long Clock Signed Budgen Croydon. This is probably Thomas Budgen who was working at Croydon circa 1735-37. George II Period. (There were also clocks signed in error as Budgen Croydon.) (Many Engravers were Dutch and, so with the language differences, errors regularly crept in.) From 1750- 1824 there was also a William Budgen and from 1838-2851 there was a John Budgen of Croydon, who were presumably related to Thomas. The case of Golden Oak is Good, Sound & Stable. Long Full Length Trunk Door with Shaped Surround Edging and Attractive Patination. The Hood with Reeded Columns Built into the Glass Door. Height 86.65 or 220.5cm Width 48cm Depth 23cm The 8 Day Movement Strikes the Number of Hours on the O'clock & has a Working Strike / Silent Dial. The Brass Dial Additionally has a Seconds Dial, Working Date Date Window & Gilt Spandrels of Rare Design. Checked, Serviced & Tested - Good Working Antique Order. We acquired this Clock Privately.
