Description

A hand-forged wrought iron hearth footman dating to around the turn of the 19th century, the slatted rectangular top with lapped frame joints, united by a central hand-peened transverse spine and raised on six baluster legs, the whole displaying a rich, dark graphite patinated finish. Built to support heavy iron vessels directly before large country-house open fires, the rare six-legged architecture and fully riveted spine reflect heavy-gauge Georgian blacksmithing at its finest. Its low, broad footprint makes it physically ideal as a hearth stand within an open fireplace recess, or as a low floor stand for heavyweight planter urns. Very good antique condition, exhibiting authentic pitting and oxidation to the iron surfaces consistent with age and hearth exposure.
