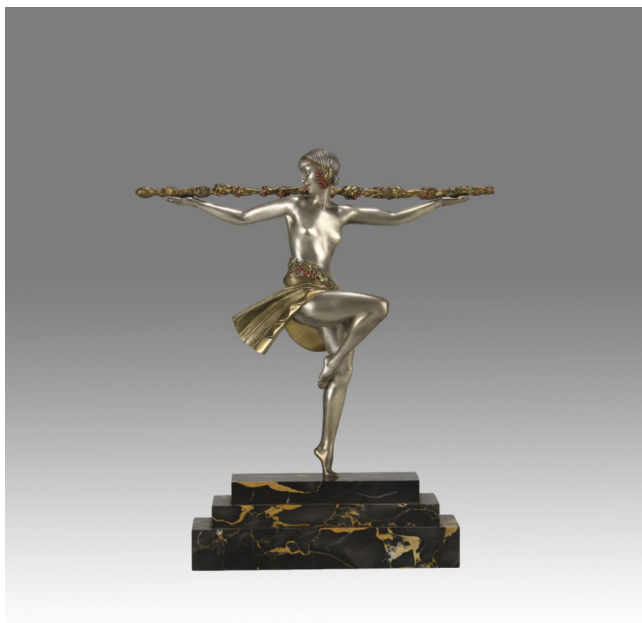

Le Faguays was awarded a Medal of Honour for his work in 1927, establishing his reputation as one of the leading sculptors of the period. He was a close friend and artistic associate of Max Le Verrie...
