Description

An exceptional and monumental late Victorian rosewood display cabinet, attributed to Collinson & Lock of London, dating to approximately 1885–1895 and conceived in the sophisticated Renaissance Revival taste associated with the firm's most ambitious late nineteenth-century furniture. Standing an impressive 200 cm high and 183 cm wide, the cabinet combines richly figured rosewood with extensive engraved pale inlay, glazed and mirrored display sections, open shelves, classical pilasters and an imposing architectural pediment. Of particular significance is the survival of a complete suite of high-quality Victorian lock furniture. Every lock examined on the cabinet is stamped "COPE & COLLINSON", with the locks additionally marked "WARRANTED / HAND MADE / LEVER". Cope & Collinson were important specialist manufacturers of locks and cabinet hardware whose products are documented on furniture securely identified as being by Collinson & Lock. The upper section centres upon a substantial glazed vitrine enclosed by a pair of doors and crowned by a bold arched pediment. This is enriched with finely executed pale inlay depicting scrolling foliage and opposing fantastical creatures...
