There is fluted design to the sides, beaded detail and it stands on acanthus leaf toupie feet and it is surmounted with an urn and floral display. The case has inset flat and rounded porcelain panels with finely painted flowers, musical instruments and male and female in traditional attire within a gilt and pink border. The clock has a white porcelain dial with Roman and Arabic numerals and a French eight day duration movement which strikes the hours and half hours on a bell. The back plate is stamped with the makers name - Japy Freres. The clock movement has been cleaned and serviced and comes with a 12 month guarantee.
