~ Japanese Meiji Period Cloisonné Enamel Charger c1880 This exquisite charger from the Meiji period (1868-1912) depicts two birds on a deep bird's-egg blue ground, amongst flowers, with an intricate border. One bird has caught its breakfast whilst the other searches. The reverse body has extensive enamelled designs, scrolling and floral, a raised rim foot, a slightly misshapen foot with some enamel lifted around the edge, but it sits flat and is a rare design. The main body decoration is in very good condition, with a diameter of 31cm and raised 4cm this is a very attractive and decorative piece. A popular subject matter. ~ Condition ~ There is some crazing to the enamel and a few very minor areas of loss, predominantly around the base of the foot rim. ~ Dimensions ~ The charger is 31 cm in diameter and 4 cm high.
