He is considered the most important Spanish artist of the late 18th and early 19th centuries and throughout his long career was a commentator and chronicler of his era. **BORN:** 30 March 1746, Fuendetodos, Spain **DIED:** 16 April 1828, Bordeaux, France **PERIODS:** Romanticism, Rococo **FULL NAME:** Francisco José de Goya y Lucientes **NATIONALITY:** Spanish **CHILDREN:** Francisco Javier Goya Bayeu. This later portrait dating around the mid 20th century, is a good copy after the original, depicting 'Isabel Lobo Velasco de Porcel', who was born at Ronda around 1780 and was the second wife of Antonio Porcel. Isabel's husband was 25 years older than she; they met when she was 20 years old. Antonio Porcel was a liberal and associate of Manuel Godoy, Prince of Peace, who was a friend of Gaspar Melchor de Jovellanos, who in turn brought him in contact with Goya, who lived nearby.
