A floral scrolled silvered engraved dial with a strike/silent lever to the top and blued steel hands. A superbly engineered triple fusee mechanism striking the quarters on a rack of bells and the hours. The original pendulum transportation lock and crank winding key. Circa 1850. George Wadham of Bath worked in Milsom Street and Bridge Street from 1846-1878.
