The head pulls off to reveal a partial hallmark. As befits a piece of this quality, the hallmarks are hidden away, underneath the neck. He stands proudly and the detailing of the body is fantastic. The silver is in excellent condition. I am no bird expert and have described it as a snipe. I think the neck is too thin for a woodcock and the legs not long enough for a curlew, but I am happy to be corrected! Dimensions: Weight: 24g Length: 5.5cm Height: 3.5cm Width: 2cm.
