The suite comprises four matching "Spoon-Back Medallion" chairs and the highly coveted tri-form "Classical Maiden Mask" bistro table. The chairs feature an intricately pierced, oval spoon-back design centered with a classical medallion frame, gracefully bordered by swags, scrolls, and delicate botanical foliage. The matching table is a masterclass in Victorian industrial casting, featuring three elegant, scrolling cabriole legs topped with prominent, beautifully crisp classical female maiden masks. The table is further enhanced by an openwork under-tier shelf and a central parasol portal. The uniform design cohesion between the scrolling legs of the chairs and the table...
