The interior is thoughtfully arranged, with generous hanging space over three short drawers and one long drawer, offering excellent versatility for storing clothing, linens and accessories. The whole piece stands firmly on an enclosed plinth base, ensuring stability and presence. In the distinctive Pugin-inspired Arts & Crafts style, this untouched wardrobe comes apart into three sections, cornice, cupboard and plinth base, making it practical to transport and install. Both highly functional and visually impressive, this fine quality Scottish Arts & Crafts wardrobe is an ideal addition to any refined bedroom, dressing room or hallway...
