Description

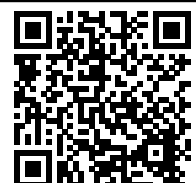
A sampler created in the reign of George IV featuring alphabet, numbers and a verse or prayer. Decorated with a crown, thistles, birds and flowers with a scrolling border. Made by Mary Main and dated August 3rd 1829. There has been some fading of the colours but generally this is in very good condition in a Rosewood frame. One of a small collection of six samplers bought mainly in the 70s and 80s by a couple now downsizing. Size - 17"(43cms) x 14.5"(37cms)
