The top is inset with a flush cast brass carrying handle with beautiful engraving, complimenting the brass mounted escutcheon which houses the working tasselled key. The interior is lucky enough to have retained it's silk and velvet lined finish with a removable tray. Some staining to the fabric to be expected after 150 years, but mentioned for accuracy.
