The back is decorated in a foliate design and has a vacant cartouche. The watch is key wound and set and the movement is clean. There are clear hallmarks dating the watch to 1883. The key is attached to the silver Albert chain with T bar and clip to attach to watch loop. The chain is hallmarked for sterling silver to the T bar, the clasp and each of the links.
