Description

A wonderful and most unusual double sauce tureen, as usable today as 130 years ago when it was made. The underside is marked for the well renowned silversmith, John Round & Son of Sheffield, together with their trademark, "All The Round" within a circle. The two tureens each stand on attractive ball and claw feet. The domed lids are both engraved with a decorative monogram, once removed the interiors are revealed with a lavish gilded finish. These usually come without ladles but my silversmith was able to find me two period examples perfectly suited to this piece, each again with a monogram on the end, obviously not matching the one on the lid as they didn't start life together, the bowls of the ladles are too washed in gold. The entire piece is decorated with shell motifs from the handsome carrying handle to the tureen rims. Excellent condition, dating to the Victorian era, around 1880.
