Description

A wonderful quality Victorian Tantalus, which I have had my silversmith dismantle and re-plate all the silver fittings, now looking sensational against the warm rich Oak. The sides are an unusual shape again with silver plated mounts, one side acting as an escutcheon and housing the working tassel key. The key when turned operates the very unusual mechanism, with the interior of the caddy falling to allow access to the three cut crystal decanters. The three cut crystal decanters are the original, with the top two thirds cut in the ever-popular hobnail design, all topped with three multi-faceted original stoppers, all in excellent condition. The underside of the Oak frame is mounted with a shield shaped plaque, bearing the silversmith's makers mark for BOURNE & O'NEILL of Birmingham, a partnership of Henry Bourne and Daniel J. O'Neill. Fabulous quality and condition, the footprint measuring 14" x 6" and standing 14 3/4" tall to top of handle. Each bottle has a base measurement of 3 1/4" square x 9" tall to top of stoppers.
