In a plain design, the flask is lightly engraved to the front for the Scottish Fullerton clan as follows: A camel's head crest and the Latin inscription Lux Intenebris. The rear of the flask is in a curved shape. Overall condition is good with a few dings and scratches as to be expected of a used piece over 120 years old. The maker's hallmarks date the piece to the Victorian era between 1880 and 1887 though the actual date letter is worn. Overall a very collectable antique piece.
