Date and seconds indicators and a name cartouche below the winding holes. A quality 8-day duration, 5-pillar mechanism striking the hours on a bell. John Snelling of Alton is recorded in Baillies' 'Watchmakers and Clockmakers of The World' book as working from 1761-1795. Height 7ft 2 " / 218 cms
