A rare and unique early English fusee dial clock. A convex wooden dial with original pheasant painting. Signed 'E.D. HERBERT PUGH' and dated 1818. An early feature of rass hands and a convex glass to the cast brass bezel. A shaped plated fusee mechanism of 8-day duration. A mahogany case. The clock was purchased directly from the owner who bought it in the 1960's from her old primary school, Wargrave Piggott in Reading where it had been many years.
