The box is trimmed in Ebony and decorated with intricate and exquisite Tunbridge inlay. To the centre of the lid, there is a iridescent tablet of Mother of Pearl shell surrounded by Tulipwood cross-banding and various stringing inlays. This is also the case for the escutcheon to the front of the box. The box has been professionally relined with a hand marbled paper to create a fresh and very usable interior.
