Still Life of a Bowl Of Flowers. Will Longstaff Australian Painter and war artist. Cousin of Australian Portrait artist Sir John Longstaff. After studying Art he joined the army and served in Boer war/ later enlisted Australian Imperial force- injured in Gallipoli Campaign. Eventually evacuated to England where he resumed his artist career.(exhibited Royal academy)and appointed official war artist in 1918 and produced numerous themes of western front. Remained in England and settled in Sussex. His style has a light impressionistic influence and developed a use of bold/pure colour. He also produced quite intimate/domestic works such as this Still Life probably painted in the late 1920's. Signed in lower right corner. Original frame. dimensions - width - 27 inches height - 26 inches. Ready to be hung in the home.
