A good quality example of a Victorian silver helmet jug in the Georgian style. The body is fluted and engraved with the unusual motif of a bow, quiver full of arrows, three co-joined circles and flowers. To the front is a vacant shield shaped cartouche. It stands on a square pedestal foot, with blaze engraving. Condition :- Very good, with no dents or splits. There are two small parallel scores across the inner lip, commensurate with age and use. Hallmarks :- Softening but readable. Loss to the maker's mark. Height :- 15.5 cms (highest point). Length (lip to outer handle) :- 13 cms.
