The Exeter assay office closed in 1883, therefore such provincial silver pieces with their hallmarks are more scarce and very collectable. Size-6.5 inches long by 7/8 inches wide. Weight- heavy at 43 grams. Nicely scrolled contemporary initial W to the front of the stem. A good and collectable piece of Exeter provincial silver, with a very good weight, which will make a great addition to a canteen of Georgian silver, or a lovely gift. With very clear hallmarks. With a tiny nick to the front of one tine, in very good condition overall.
