A delightful early nineteenth century monocular, used for the Opera or simply focusing on the other end of a grand ballroom. The beautiful casting makes this a very tactile example with an all over design and retaining the original gilding. This is a four drawer example dating to around 1820 and signed by Richard Ebsworth, 41 Fleet Street, London; a philosophical, mathematical and optical instrument maker, was working from 1820 to 1835, but was only at this address between 1820 and 1826, allowing us to date it very accurately. Fully operational with good clear optics. Excellent original condition with a diameter measuring 1 3/8" in diameter and 1 1/2" tall extending to 3 1/4" when fully opened.
