## Description

A rare Chuval (bedding-bag) made by the Karadashli Turkmen during the mid 19th century in very good condition with original selvages albeit the original flatwoven back is missing. Work of the Karadashli is often confused for Yomut Turkmen weavings - the fine structure in this case has woollen warps and cotton wefts whereas the Yomut use entirely woollen warps and wefts. This is a very collectable piece. Size: 1.14m x 0.74m (3' 9" x 2' 5").
