The outside of the case bears a Patent Number, 15061 and the initials E.J.T. contained in a Victorian belt cartouche. The case opens just like a pocket watch with a push button on the top, all in perfect working order. The bottom of the little spirit cup again contains the very English belt cartouche, this one having an English Registration number for the year 1886 and the maker's initials C.T & S. The cup has a gilded finish expands and then collapses back into the case. Excellent condition, the case measuring 1 7/8" in diameter x 2 1/2" including ring.
