Description

A nice quality oak cased clock by SAMUAL HILL of SHEFFIELD. An unusual 13" dia. silvered dial with black Roman numerals and an outer ring of "tumbling" numbers in Arabic style. There is nice engraving to the centre. The case is made of quarter-cut oak which enhances both the grain and the medullary rays. It is nicely polished with a rich, warm patina. The quarter columns to the trunk door, the reeded columns to the hood, the bezel to the clock face, and the arch to the hood are all in mahogany, further enhancing the appearance of the clock. The base has a raised and fielded panel and the clock stands on its original ogee bracket feet. The 8 day movement strikes on a bell and has just been fully overhauled by our BHI registered staff. Samuel Hill worked in Sheffield between 1770 to 1814. Many of his clocks had round dials; a rather unique feature for the period. Dimensions: 89" Height
