This Salt-Bag, intricately woven in weft-float brocade, was made by the Sangtschuli tribe - a sub group of the Timuri of western Afghanistan - during the second half of the 19th century. Such bags are now rare and very few are to be found in Iran. I found this bag in Iran back in the 1990s - sold it almost immediately on my return - and have just acquired it back!
