A most unusual collector's item of Victorian silver. This delightful vesta has a central thumb-slide, which pushes up the striker. The striker is hinged and can be moved away to allow access to the matches. A most interesting piece for the collector. Condition :- Very good. The vesta has no splits or losses. The sliding mechanism is good and the vesta closes tightly. There are some dimples and blemishes front and back, commensurate with age and use. (photos 1 and 2). Hallmarks :- Fully marked to body and part marked to slider and again to interior of striker. Maker :- Henry Williamson. Length :- 5 cms. Width :- 3.75 cms.
